The Greater St Louis Art Association is offering scholarships to high school seniors in the St Louis area who are planning to major in Art. Scholarships are one-time awards up to \$1500 per student.

- The applicant must submit a fully completed application with six (6) images of his or her recent art work, whether digital images (preferred), slides or photographs. The GSLAA Scholarship committee will review each applicant's submission and select a group of finalists.
- Scholarship winners will be chosen by the full board of directors of the organization, and will be notified as soon as possible.
- Scholarship winners will be requested to exhibit two or three pieces of art work at The Art Fair at Queeny Park (April 4-6, 2010). Scholarship winners will be announced to the public at the Festival.

Applicants MUST enclose a stamped, self addressed envelope, with sufficient postage to return their images.

Only applications received by **the due date** will be considered. Only **fully completed** applications will be considered. All information must be true and accurate.
