ARTISTIC MERIT SCHOLARSHIP

The Greater St. Louis Art Association is offering scholarships to college students in the St. Louis area who are majoring in Art. Scholarships are one-time awards up to \$2500 per student.

- The applicant must be a full or half-time college student (minimum of 6 credit hours) majoring in an art discipline.
- The applicant must submit a fully completed application with six (6) images of his or her recent artwork in a PowerPoint file. Detailed instructions for the PowerPoint file are on the next page. The GSLAA Scholarship Committee will review each applicant's submission and select a group of finalists.
- Applications deadline is March 15, 2020..
- Scholarship winners will be chosen by the full Board of Directors of the GSLAA organization. Students will be notified March 20, 2020.
- Scholarship winners will be invited to exhibit three to five pieces of artwork at The Art Fair at Queeny Park (April 3, 4 & 5, 2020). Scholarship winners will be announced to the public at 10:30AM on Saturday, April 4, 2020, at the Art Fair at Queeny Park.

Only applications received by the due date, March 15, 2020, will be considered. All applications must be in the format of a PowerPoint file.

Only fully completed applications will be considered. All information must be true and accurate. ALL information on the application will remain confidential

Cover Slide: Your NAME and college attending.

If you are planning to transfer schools, please indicate where you plan to attend next year.

Slides 1 through 6: Images of your artwork.

Each slide must include:

- your name; your college;
- the title of the work; year completed;
- the medium and dimensions of the work.

Slide 7: Your completed application.

A digital copy of your application. Blank application forms are attached to this download for you to complete and scan into your PowerPoint file.

Slide 8: A brief Artist's Statement . This is optional but highly recommended.

Slide 9: Resume.

A digital copy of your resume may be included. This is also optional.
